

## Passiv Englisch

### Die Zeiten im Überblick

#### 1. Die Bildung von Passivsätzen

Du bildest das englische Passiv nach folgender Regel:

***form of to be + past participle (= dritte Verbform)***

Diese Regel bleibt in allen Zeiten bestehen. Die Bildungsregel der verschiedenen Zeiten wendest du stets auf das Hilfsverb to be an. Das Vollverb bleibt im Past Participle immer unverändert. Wir haben dir im folgenden eine Übersicht über alle Zeiten inklusive ihrer Bildungsregeln zusammengestellt.

#### 2. Übersicht

Zeit	Aktiv	Passiv
<b>Simple Present</b>	Ahmed does his homework. <i>infinitive oder infinitive + s bei he, she, it</i>	The homework is done by Ahmed. <i>form of to be + past participle</i>
<b>present progressive</b>	Ahmed is doing his homework. <i>form of to be + verb + ing</i>	The homework is being done by Ahmed. <i>form of to be + be + ing + past participle</i>
<b>Simple Past</b>	Ahmed did his homework. <i>infinitive + ed oder zweite Verbform</i>	The homework was done by Ahmed. <i>Zweite Verbform von to be (was/were) + past participle</i>
<b>Present Perfect</b>	Ahmed has done his homework. <i>Have/has + infinitive + ed oder dritte Verbform</i>	The homework has been done by Ahmed. <i>Have/has + dritte Verbform von to be + past participle</i>
<b>Past Perfect</b>	Ahmed had done his homework. <i>Had + infinitive + ed oder dritte Verbform</i>	The homework had been done by Ahmed. <i>Had + dritte Verbform von to be + past participle</i>
<b>will-future</b>	Ahmed will do his homework. <i>will + infinitive</i>	The homework will be done by Ahmed. <i>will + infinitive of to be + past participle</i>
<b>will-future II</b>	Ahmed will have done his homework. <i>will + have + infinitive + ed oder dritte Verbform</i>	The homework will have been done by Ahmed. <i>will + have + dritte Verbform of to be + past participle</i>
<b>going-to-future</b>	Ahmed is going to do his homework. <i>form of to be + going to + infinitive</i>	The homework is going to be done by Ahmed. <i>form of to be + going to + infinitive of to be + past participle</i>

<b>Conditional I</b>	Ahmed would do his homework.  <i>would + infinitive</i>	The homework would be done by Ahmed.  <i>would + infinitive of to be + past participle</i>
<b>Conditional II</b>	Ahmed would have done his homework.  <i>would + have + infinitive + ed oder dritte Verbform</i>	The homework would have been done by Ahmed.  <i>would + have + dritte form von to be + past participle</i>
